St. Patrick's Day is the Roman Catholic feast day that honors St. Patrick (387-461 AD), the patron saint of Ireland.

Because of St. Patrick's patronage, St. Patrick's Day

(March 17) has come to be closely associated with Ireland and Irish culture. Since the earliest centuries of Christianity, it has been a custom to celebrate the anniversary of saints' deaths. A "fast day" is designated for every saint, even when the exact date of death of a saint is not known. St. Patrick was a fifth-century English missionary to Ireland. Scholars agree he is a historical figure and that he converted many of the pagans on the island to Christianity, but dismiss most of the legend that has developed about him over the centuries. The feast day of St. Patrick has been observed in Ireland on March 17 for thousands of years. The date falls during the fasting season of Lent, but on St. Patrick's Day the prohibitions against eating meat were lifted, and the Irish would celebrate their patron saint feasting on traditional meal of Irish bacon and cabbage.
